The last resolutions communiqué asked you to begin working on the action plans for National Resolutions: **2019.01 Canada to Honour its Commitment to the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child; 2019.02 Canadian support for the United Nations Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons**; and the Provincial Resolution **2019.01 In-School Dental Screening for Children in Alberta Grades K-12**. How are things going with that? Have you received any replies to your letters? If you have sent letters, please keep track of the subject matter and to which MP or MLA you wrote, and if you received a reply.

The updates to the resolutions supplement for the Executive Handbook have been completed and are available on the CWL website: www.cwl.ca for you to download. A copy of the supplement will also be emailed to you. Please review it. We are now directed to use the new format for writing resolutions.

In late February a committee from Provincial Council will meet with ministers of the Alberta Legislature. We will bring to their attention: **the Seniors' Advocate Initiative; Resolution 2015.01 Establish Provincial/Territorial Protocols for Child Welfare Interventions; Resolution 2018.01 Official Recognition of Obesity as a Chronic Disease; and Resolution 2019.01 In-School Dental Screening for Children in Alberta Grades K-12**.

Please pray for the success of this meeting and that the Alberta Government will recognize that the Catholic Women's League seeks only the best for the citizens of Alberta Mackenzie.
